Our organisation

VicTrack is custodial owner of Victoria's rail transport land, assets and infrastructure. We work to protect and grow the value of the portfolio, to support a thriving transport system and make travel and living better for all Victorians. With much of our asset portfolio dedicated to rail transport – our land, infrastructure, trams, trains and telecommunication networks – our focus is on strategic asset management and supporting the delivery of better transport solutions.

Whether we're planning and managing the use of transport land, upgrading the telecommunication network or partnering on major infrastructure projects, our job is to ensure the state's assets continue to serve Victoria now and well into the future.

Our core functions include:

- delivering telecommunications infrastructure and services that form the backbone of the transport network from signalling, driver communications, public information displays and myki ticketing
- managing land set aside for transport purposes, including the development and sale of land no longer required for transport to optimise its use
- generating income through land sales and commercial leases that is reinvested into the state's transport system
- providing project management, engineering and construction services to deliver a range of government transport projects from Victoria's Big Build to station and car park upgrades
- managing transport facilities and assets, including the open access Dynon Rail Freight Terminal, heritage buildings and environmental preservation.

VicTrack is the custodial owner of most of Victoria's tourist and heritage assets and performs the role of Tourist and Heritage Registrar.

Purpose of the position

The Senior Legal Counsel is responsible for provision of legal services, and legal advice and guidance, to internal and relevant external stakeholders in relation to all legal and corporate governance matters as requested within VicTrack.

Performing the role of a generalist lawyer advising across the broad range of VicTrack’s legal issues, you will have the opportunity to build on your existing legal expertise and

specialisation across our key areas of focus – commercial, property, construction, telecommunications and litigation.

Key accountabilities/functions

- Act as senior legal counsel for VicTrack, providing timely and pragmatic, strategic legal advice to the General Counsel and VicTrack's business units, to deliver high quality legal services and outcomes.
- Providing expert advice on legal issues arising from VicTrack's operating environment, including by identifying and resolving legal risks, to enable confident decision-making and deliver operational and strategic outcomes.
- Draft and settle a broad range of agreements and legal documents, having an appreciation for VicTrack's core interests and risks, whilst simultaneously ensuring compliance with core legislative and regulatory requirements.
- Engage with key business areas and develop strategic approaches with regards to contracts for tenders, expressions of interest, requests for tender documents, panel arrangement documentation and participation in risk reviews and proponent evaluation as a subject matter expert.
- Managing and instructing external legal providers, to ensure the efficient delivery of legal services and value for money to VicTrack.
- From time to time, providing advice on disputes and litigation, negotiating pragmatic solutions that may resolve matters without formal litigation and interacting with insurers.
- Develop and manage legal precedents and assist with supporting the compliance and risk functions within the business.
- Mentoring and managing (as required) junior lawyers, including settling their work products and sharing with them knowledge and specialist expertise.
- Assisting the General Counsel, in relation to governance matters, including VicTrack Board and committee functions and papers.

Customer focus

VicTrack staff practise customer focus by recognising the importance of valuing customers (internal and external) and ensuring that all activities are oriented towards meeting customer needs. - be responsible for their actions where those actions can in any way affect or compromise railway safety
- be aware of the railway safety requirements associated with their duties and responsibilities
- take whatever action is possible to prevent unsafe conditions and/or incidents
- report any railway safety problems/hazards to the Manager Safety
- safely access the rail corridor.
