Our organisation

VicTrack is custodial owner of Victoria's rail transport land, assets and infrastructure. - managing transport facilities and assets, including the open access Dynon Rail Freight Terminal, heritage buildings and environmental preservation.

VicTrack is the custodial owner of most of Victoria's tourist and heritage assets and performs the role of Tourist and Heritage Registrar.

Rail Safety Worker

The Senior Presales Engineer is considered a Rail Safety Worker in accordance with Rail Safety National Law (RSNL) specifically in regard to the design of telecommunications systems relating to rail infrastructure.



Purpose of the position

The Senior Presales Engineer works within the Sales team, and also works directly with customers and subject matter experts within VicTrack and external third parties in order to accurately understand and scope significant customer requirements. This requires an excellent understanding of the customer environment and knowledge of previous complex projects and issues.

The Senior Presales Engineer supports the Sales team to achieve revenue targets and identify new opportunities. The Senior Presales Engineer will also provide technical support, guidance and mentoring to other Presales Engineers and other engineering teams when required.

Key accountabilities/functions

The Senior Presales Engineer is solution focused to deliver, maintain and assist with the development of customer relationships through technical and commercial knowledge and will:

- Provide support and guidance to the Sales team by:
 - attending customer visits and meetings and determining accurate requirements
 - costing customer solutions including services, equipment and infrastructure based on technical requirements
 - identifying solution risks, proposing and costing mitigating strategies.

Within timeframe relative to scope of the proposal (project) and customer requirements:

- develop relationships with customers and other stakeholders such that the Senior Presales Engineer is seen as a trusted technical advisor and to help meet VicTrack's sales targets
- organise regular meetings as required with the Sales team and other stakeholders to discuss and update status of quotes and bids to keep consistency and manage timelines.
- participate in the development and maintenance of the VicTrack service catalogue and other product management initiatives to provide ease of use for customers
- lead customer proof of concepts in conjunction with the Products team to develop new and emerging technologies.
- Lead and manage responses to complex tenders and RFQs to win business for VicTrack in meeting financial targets.
- Lead the development of product and solution presentations to customers and stakeholders.
- Provide expertise in the execution of the presales processes by consulting and liaising with stakeholders from other teams and providing guidance in presales operation and improvement.
- Examine operational requirements, in conjunction with the Network Architect, for engineering works and telecommunications facilities to determine appropriate technology and techniques to be adopted to meet future requirements, and participate in vendor and product selection.
- Participate in project handover and lead lessons learned sessions. When required, provide support to the Network Design, Infrastructure Design and Network Delivery teams in the initial phases of a project to ensure a smooth handover is achieved.
- Provide induction to new Presales Engineers about VicTrack solutions and processes, including guiding other Presales Engineers on the use of tools and processes, reviewing their jobs and sharing information and experience to cover exclusions and considerations correctly.
- Support the Sales team to identify training and improvement needs for Presales Engineers.

Customer focus

VicTrack staff practise customer focus by recognising the importance of valuing customers (internal and external) and ensuring that all activities are oriented towards meeting customer needs. We listen to customers about their expectations and focus on delivering solutions that address their needs. Customer focus also includes proactively seeking and acting on feedback to enhance the customer experience.

- take whatever action is possible to prevent unsafe conditions and/or incidents
- report any railway safety problems/hazards to the Manager Safety
- · safely access the rail corridor.
